## Harvest Service

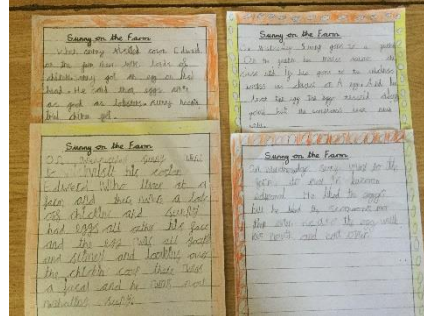

Your child may be eligible for a Free School Meal. This depends on whether you receive certain benefits. Your child would get a Free School Meal all through primary school even if you stop receiving the benefit before Year 6. Otherwise, school meals are only free up to Year 2.
